

## **PRZEMYSŁAW LIS**

Born on October 2nd 1963, Przemysław Lis obtained a degree in Law from the University of Wrocław in 1989. He has completed legal training as an attorney-at-law at the bar associations in Zielona Góra and Wrocław. In 1994, he began his career as an attorney-at-law, both individually and as part of legal firm Consensus Messrs A. Malicki, H. Rossa and P. Lis. He has also been Managing Partner of Lis i Partnerzy since 2004. Mr Lis has served on professional self-government bodies as a judge of the disciplinary tribunal at the Bar Association in Wrocław.

Przemysław Lis specialises in contract law (especially business and construction contracts) and is an expert in the legal aspects of construction projects, public procurement law, local government law, and broadly-understood criminal law, with particular focus on penal economic law. A renowned specialist in the legal aspects of business transactions, Mr Lis serves as an advisor to the largest companies in the waste management industry. He represented the Association of Employers in the Waste Management Industry during negotiations with the Agency for Restructuring and Modernisation of Agriculture and the Minister of Agriculture, as well as in its contacts with the Agricultural Committee of the Polish Sejm.
